Attendance in Physical Education classes is compulsory. Students must be dressed to participate for the first class.

Students must select three Physical Education courses; one 109-103-02 and one 109-104-02 course which are pre-requisites and must be passed before registering for the third course 109-105-02.

It is recommended but not essential that students select a 109-103-02 course before a 109-104-02 course.

All 109-103-02 sections are titled "Health and Physical Education"; 109-104-02 sections are titled "Physical Activity"; and 109-105-02 sections are titled "Active Living". Please take note of the subtitle as well as the course number when registering.
